Meet The Grand Marshal, Michael J. Dowling

The Huntington Ancient Order of Hibernians is proud to have Northwell Health president and CEO Michael J. Dowling as Grand Marshal for the 2022 St. Patrick's Day parade..

A true son of Ireland, Mr. Dowling grew up in Knockaderry, County Limerick, and today calls Northport home. He has led Northwell Health – New York's largest health care provider – as CEO since 2002.

As president and CEO of Northwell Health, he leads a clinical, academic and research enterprise with a workforce of more than 77,000 and annual revenue of \$15 billion. Northwell is the largest health care provider and private employer in New York State, caring for more than two million people annually through a vast network of more than 830 outpatient facilities, including 220 primary care practices, 52 urgent care centers, home care, rehabilitation and end-of-life programs, and 22 hospitals. Northwell also pursues pioneering research at the Feinstein Institutes for Medical Research and a visionary approach to medical education highlighted by the Zucker School of Medicine, the Hofstra Northwell School of Nursing and Physician Assistant Studies, and one of the nation's largest medical residency and fellowship programs. Mr. Dowling's leadership has been invaluable to Northwell's consistent expansion and prominence. In 2020, he successfully navigated the health

system through the first COVID-19 epicenter in the US, detailing his experiences in *Leading* Through a Pandemic: The Inside Story of Humanity, Innovation, and Lessons Learned During the COVID-19 Crisis. Northwell utilized a strong innovative culture to expand hospital bed capacity (adding 2,000 beds in two weeks), 3D-print nasal swabs for COVID testing, convert bi-level positive airway pressure (BiPAP) machines into mechanical ventilators and take advantage of its large, integrated health system to "load balance" and transport 810 patients from overrun hospitals to those that had bed capacity. Northwell also kept employees safe, investing in critical personal protective equipment to help those working the front lines, one of whom—Sandra Lindsay—was the first person in the US to receive the historic COVID vaccine in December 2020.

Prior to becoming president and CEO in 2002, Mr. Dowling was the health system's executive vice president and chief operating officer. Before joining Northwell Health in 1995, he was a senior vice president at Empire Blue Cross/Blue Shield. Mr. Dowling served in New York State government for 12 years, including seven years as state director of Health, Education and Human Services and deputy secretary to the governor. He was also commissioner of the New York State Department of Social Services.


Before his public service career, Mr. Dowling was a professor of social policy and assistant dean at the Fordham University Graduate School of Social Services, and director of the Fordham campus in Westchester County.

Mr. Dowling has been honored with many awards over the years, including his selection as the Grand Marshal of the 2017 St. Patrick's Day Parade in New York City, the Presidential Distinguished Service Award for Irish Abroad, induction into the Irish America Hall of Fame, and the Ellis Island Medal of Honor, In 2020, Mr. Dowling received the Deming Cup from the Columbia School of Business and was ranked No. 2 on Modern Healthcare's 100 Most Influential People in Healthcare, his highest ranking in 13 years appearing on the list. Ranked No. 44 among large company CEOs in the US, he was the nation's top-ranking health care/hospital CEO on Glassdoor's Top CEOs in 2019 list.

Mr. Dowling is past chair of the Healthcare Institute and the current chair of the Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI). He is a member of the Institute of Medicine of the National Academies of Sciences and the North American Board of the Smurfit School of Business at University College, Dublin, Ireland.

A Grand Huntington Tradition: 88th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade

The Ancient Order of Hibernians (AOH) Division 4 will host its 88th annual Huntington St. Patrick's Day parade on Sunday, March 13, 2022. The parade kicks-off at 2 pm near the Huntington LIRR train station and proceeds north along New York Avenue (Rte. 110) before turning west onto Main Street (Rte. 25A) and ending at St. Patrick's Church.

Long Island's oldest and largest, this grand parade has a rich history dating back to the early 1930's when the nation was in the grips of the Great Depression.

Finnegan's opened the day after Prohibition ended to cater to the growing population of Irish workers. Down the street, Valencia Tavern opened on the very same day to cater

to the Italian laborers. Although times were tough, a great community tradition was started when the entire town came together to celebrate the first St. Patrick's Day Parade held anywhere on Long Island.

Eighty-eight years later, residents continue to celebrate the unofficial start of spring on the second Sunday of March when the St. Patrick's Parade marches through Huntington village.

On that day, members of the Irish-American fraternal organization the Ancient Order of Hibernians will lead the march dressed in their distinctive gray morning suit tuxedos.

At the head of the parade will be Grand Marshal Michael J. Dowling and his Aides, leading bands, schoolchildren and scouts, fire departments and community groups to the reviewing stand at the western end of Main Street.

The core of the parade is of course the bagpipe bands and no parade on Long Island can match Huntington's lineup. Pipe bands from all over the Island and New York City consider Huntington to be one of the finest parades around. Among the bands which make Huntington a regular stop on their parade calendars is Clann Eireann Irish Pipe Band, the parade's lead pipe band for decades. Brooklyn-based Clann Eireann is the oldest, continuous independent Pipe Band in the United States. Huntington A.O.H's "home band," the Northport Pipe and Drum Band, and many more will delight

thousands of spectators on the parade route.

Ancient Order of Hibernians members are proud to Michael Dowling leading the division down the streets of Huntington as the Grand Marshal.

Mr. Dowling, the president and CEO of Northwell Health, is a true son of Ireland who hails from County Limerick.

Like so many events, last year's parade was held virtually and while it was fun, there's no substitute for the cheering crowds, crisp March air and the sound of approaching bagpipes.

A.O.H. members are eager to get back on the streets for a live parade... we'll see you there. Just be sure to arrive early to stake out the best view.





Jim Regan Memorial Food Drive, not only continuing his work but greatly expanding it."



They expanded to many countries in Africa, Brazil and Mexico.


Their story is that of some of the most dedicated women ever to leave Ireland's shores.
